Description:

90 Halsey Reed Road is a two-story-tall, four-bay-wide, two-bay-deep, frame dwelling built circa 1880 in the Greek Revival. The dwelling consists of a side-gabled main block, with a two-story, rear (west) ell and a hipped-roof, enclosed porch extending from the south elevation of the main block (likely added in the early twentieth century). The roof is sheathed in asphalt shingles. An exterior, brick chimney extends above the north gable end. The exterior of the dwelling is clad in aluminum siding. Windows throughout consist of one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement units, flanked by inoperable vinyl shutters on the primary (east) elevation of the main block. The primary elevation has symmetrical fenestration. The central, primary entrance contains a metal storm door and wood panel door, set within a wood surround featuring a segmented transom and sidelights and topped by a broken pediment (historic, likely original). The entrance is accessed by a brick stoop with metal railings. The north elevation of the main block has symmetrical fenestration. The south gable end of the main block contains a louvered metal vent, with paired vinyl-sash windows on the first floor of the rear ell. The hipped-roof porch is enclosed with wood screen windows (possibly historic) and is supported by narrow wood columns. The rear elevation is not visible from the public rightof-way. The dwelling stands atop a fieldstone foundation.

An early twentieth-century, two-story-tall, two-bay-wide, frame garage stands approximately 45 feet west of the dwelling. An asphaltshingle, front-gabled roof tops the garage. Aluminum siding clads the exterior. On the primary (east) elevation, the garage contains two paneled wood roll-top doors beside a wood-plank door with four inset lights. In the primary gable end, there are two one-over-one windows flanked by inoperable, vinyl louvered shutters.

Character-defining elements of the dwelling consist of its massing, wood frieze with gable-end returns, and wood door surround with a broken pediment.

History: 90 Halsey Reed Road stylistically dates to circa 1880 and is an example of a Greek Revival-style dwelling in Cranbury. The dwelling does not appear on an 1876 map of Cranbury (Everts & Stewart 1876). Sometime during the early twentieth century, a hippedroof porch was added to the south elevation of the main block, and a one-story, detached garage was constructed west of the dwelling. Aerial photographs throughout the second half of the twentieth century and into the twenty-first century depict the dwelling in its current footprint (NETR 1940, 1957, 1979, 1987, 1995, 2002). Sometime during the late twentieth century, the dwelling's current siding and windows were installed.

90 Halsey Reed Road is sited on two irregularly shaped parcels (Block 13, Lots 3 and 4) located on the west side of Halsey Reed Road in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing east and is set back approximately 20 feet from the road. An asphalt driveway leads from the roadway to the garage and a flagstone path leads from the roadway to the primary entrance. Shrubs and hardwood trees are planted in close proximity to the dwelling. A wood fence borders the rear yard of the property. The subject property is located in a residential neighborhood surrounded by properties dating from the mid-nineteenth to the early twentieth centuries.




