Description:

22 Station Road is a two-story-tall, four-bay-wide, frame dwelling constructed circa 1960 as a one-story Ranch and raised to two stories in the 1990s. The dwelling consists of a cross-gable-roof main block with a northwest wing containing an incorporated garage and a one-story, gabled east wing. Asphalt shingles cover the roof throughout. An interior, brick chimney pierces the roof ridge of the east wing. The exterior of the dwelling is primarily clad in cedar shake siding with vinyl siding covering portions of the west, east, and rear (south) elevations. Windows are generally vinyl fixed and sash replacement units organized irregularly throughout. The primary (north) elevation of the main block features an oval fixed window below the front gable and a fixed, arched multi-light window in the second floor of the cross gable. The primary entrance is recessed in the east bay and contains a two-light, paneled wood door with a glazed storm door, flanked by wood sidelights. A wood casing surrounds the entrance and features square pilasters. Two paneled, wood, roll-top doors are located on the primary elevation of the northwest garage wing. The east elevation contains an octagonal window on the second floor of the main block's cross gable. A secondary entrance, consisting of a three-light glazed sliding door, is located in the southernmost bay of the main block's cross gable. A secondary entrance, consisting of a three-light glazed sliding door, is located in the southernmost bay of the main block. The west elevation features a second-floor balcony above the garage wing, accessed by a sliding glazed door. The rear elevation is not visible from the public right-of-way.


History: 22 Station Road was constructed circa 1960 and is an example of a mid-twentieth century dwelling in Cranbury. In 1957, Robert and Audrey Stahl purchased the subject parcel from Oscar and Evelyn Danser (Middlesex County Clerk's Office 1957 Deed Book 1950:590). The subject dwelling was originally a one-story Ranch and first appears in a 1963 aerial photograph (NETR 1963). In the 1990s, the dwelling was raised to its current two-story height (Cranbury Historic Preservation Commission 2023). Sometime during the late twentieth or early twenty-first centuries, the extant vinyl windows were installed.

Setting:

22 Station Road is sited on a roughly rectangular-shaped parcel (Block 18, Lot 36.01) located on the south side of Station Road in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing north and is set back approximately 207 feet from the road. An asphalt-paved driveway extends south from Station Road and curves west in front of the north elevation to the incorporated garage. Mature trees and shrubs surround the dwelling. The subject dwelling is located in a residential neighborhood surrounded by properties generally dating from the mid-nineteenth to the late twentieth centuries.
