## **Description:**

9 Bunker Hill Drive is a one-and-a-half-story tall, three-bay wide, three-bay deep, frame private residence constructed circa 1932 in a vernacular style. The dwelling consists of a rectangular, side-gabled main block; a one-story, one-bay intersecting gable addition (built circa 1940); and a one-story enclosed porch (built circa 2000) on the rear of the dwelling. The roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles. The exterior of the dwelling is clad in vinyl siding on all elevations. An exterior brick chimney is located on the northwest elevation of the main block. A front-gabled, windowless dormer sits on the front (northeast) bent of the roof. Front-gabled dormers are located on the southeast and southwest bents of the intersecting gable addition (added in 2011). Windows on the front elevation are paired six-over-six, doublehung, wood-sash windows; the windows in the west bay have inoperable louvered shutters. The central entrance is a nine-light, two-panel wood door sheltered by a front-gabled hood and accessed via a concrete stoop with four steps and cast iron railings. The southeast elevation has single and paired six-over-one, double-hung, wood-sash windows. The northwest elevation also has single and paired sixover-one, double-hung, wood-sash windows. Windows in the dormers are six-over-one vinyl hopper windows. A one-story, frame, detached garage and a one-story, side-gabled frame shed sit southwest of the dwelling, at the end of a paved driveway.

History: 9 Bunker Hill Drive first appears cartographically on the 1933 Sanborn map of Cranbury Township as a one-story frame building with a one-story front porch in the northeast corner and a one-story frame outbuilding at the rear of the property. The intersecting gable addition first appears on historic aerial photographs in 1940. The one-story enclosed porch was constructed circa 2000. The dormers were

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added to the southeast and southwest bents of the intersecting gable addition in 2011.

#### Setting:

9 Bunker Hill Drive is sited on a rectangular parcel (Block 23, Lot 38) located on the south side of Bunker Hill Drive in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing northeast and is set back approximately 20 feet from Bunker Hill Drive. A concrete sidewalk, which runs along the south side of Bunker Hill Drive, spans the entirety of the north side of the parcel. A paved driveway leads south from Bunker Hill Drive past the southeast elevation of the dwelling to a detached garage. A minimal front lawn is planted in grass, with perennial plantings adjoining the porch and the southeast elevation. Several small trees are planted on the north side of the lawn. Shrubs line the west side of the parcel. 9 Bunker Hill Drive is located in a primarily residential neighborhood surrounded by other residential properties dating from the mid-nineteenth to the early-twentieth century.


