Description:

7 Bunker Hill Drive is a one-and-a-half-story tall, three-bay wide, three-bay deep, frame private residence constructed circa 1930 in a vernacular Bungalow form. The dwelling, which sits on a rusticated concrete block foundation, consists of a rectangular, front-gabled main block and a two-story addition (built circa 1986) to the rear. The two-story addition has multiple projecting rectangular and semi-hexagonal bays. The roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles. The exterior of the dwelling is clad in vinyl siding on all elevations with wood plank siding on the rear projecting bays. An interior stucco chimney and a shed roof dormer pierce the roof on the northwest bent. A fixed wood window with five inset lights sits in the front gable end. Windows on the front elevation are one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement windows. The central entrance is an eight-panel door, sheltered by a one-story enclosed porch with square wood posts. The northwest elevation has paired and single one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement windows. The southeast elevation also has paired and single one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement windows. Character-defining features of the building include a one-story, enclosed front porch and a five-light, fixed wood window in the front gable end. A one-story, front-gabled, frame detached garage (constructed circa 1930) sits southeast of the dwelling, at the end of a paved driveway.

History: 7 Bunker Hill Drive first appears cartographically on the 1933 Sanborn map as a one-story frame dwelling with a one-story frame garage to the southeast. The garage survives. The two-story rear addition with projecting bays first appears in historic aerials in 1987.

7 Bunker Hill Drive is sited on a rectangular parcel (Block 23, Lot 39) located on the south side of Bunker Hill Drive in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing northeast and is set back approximately 20 feet from Bunker Hill Drive. A concrete sidewalk, which runs along the south side of Bunker Hill Drive, spans the entirety of the north side of the parcel. A paved driveway leads south from Bunker Hill Drive past the southeast elevation of the dwelling to a detached garage. A minimal front lawn is planted in grass, with large shrubs adjoining the front enclosed porch. Trimmed hedges line the southeast elevation of the dwelling. 7 Bunker Hill Drive is located in a primarily residential neighborhood surrounded by other residential properties dating from the mid-nineteenth to the early-twentieth century.


