Description:

106 North Main Street is a one-and-a-half-story tall, four-bay wide, five-bay deep, frame private residence constructed circa 1915 in a Bungalow form. The dwelling consists of a rectangular main block, a one-story hipped roof wraparound porch on the front elevation, and a one-story, one-bay addition to the southeast. The hipped roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles. The exterior of the dwelling is coated with stucco on all elevations. A central brick and stucco chimney pierces the roof at the intersection of the slopes. Hipped dormers sit on the northwest and southwest slopes of the roof. The dormer on the front (northwest) elevation has paired one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement windows. The porch comprises an arcade of stucco concrete piers with vinyl sliding windows that wraps around from the front elevation to the southwest elevation. The dormer on the southwest elevation has a triple one-over-one, vinyl-sash window. The rear elevation is not visible from the public right-of-way. The southwest and northeast elevations are perforated by one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement windows. A one-story frame shed, constructed after the district's period of significance, is located east of the dwelling. Character-defining elements of the dwelling include the steeply-pitched hipped roof, hipped dormers, and arcaded porch.

History: 106 North Main Street first appears cartographically on the 1916 Sanborn map of Cranbury Township as a one-and-a-half-story frame dwelling with a one-story wraparound porch and a one-story addition to the southeast. The 1933 Sanborn map indicates no changes to the subject dwelling. Both the 1916 and 1933 Sanborn maps show a one-story frame garage east of the dwelling. According to historic aerial photographs, this garage was demolished circa 1970.

106 North Main Street is sited on a rectangular parcel (Block 26.01, Lot 15) located on the east side of North Main Street in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing northwest and is set back approximately 15 feet from North Main Street. A loose gravel driveway leads east from North Main Street to the property's lightly wooded backyard. 106 North Main Street is located in a primarily residential neighborhood surrounded by other residential properties dating from the mid-nineteenth to the early twentieth centuries.


