Description:

130 North Main Street is a one-and-one-half-story-tall, three-bay-wide, two-bay-deep, frame dwelling constructed circa 1980. The dwelling consists of a steeply pitched, side-gabled main block with a one-and-one-half-story, side-gabled, southwest wing; a one-story, gable-roof northeast wing that connects to a front-gabled garage; and a rear (southeast), two-story, front-gabled addition (added circa 1990). Asphalt shingles cover the roof throughout. An interior brick chimney pierces the roof ridge of the main block. The exterior of the dwelling is clad in vinyl siding. Windows are all six-over-six, vinyl-sash units that are generally arranged symmetrically throughout. Louvered vinyl shutters flank the windows on the primary (northwest) elevations of the main block, southwest wing, and the northeast wing, along with the first floor window on the main block's northeast elevation. Located in the southwest bay of the main block, the primary entrance contains a paneled wood door with a glazed metal storm door. A brick stoop with metal railings provides access to the entrance. The northeast wing is mostly obscured by a coniferous tree, with grouped, vinyl-sash windows centered on the primary elevation. Centered on the primary elevation of the attached garage is a single vinyl, paneled, roll-top garage door on its primary (northwest) elevation while its northeast elevation is unadorned. The rear elevation was not visible from the public right-of-way.


A circa-1982, one-story-tall, three-bay-wide, two-bay-deep, frame shed, stands approximately 50 feet east of the dwelling.

History: 130 North Main Street, constructed circa 1980, is an example of a late twentieth-century dwelling in Cranbury. In 1979, the subject property was sold to James and Ellen Suder as an empty lot (Middlesex County Clerk's Office 1979 Deed Book 3125:653; Nationwide Environmental Title Research [NETR] 1979). Likely built for the Suders shortly after they purchased the subject property, the subject dwelling first appears on a 1984 aerial photograph, with the main block, southwest wing, northeast wing, and attached garage. The circa-1982 shed was also present on the property by this time (NETR 1984). The rear addition was constructed circa 1990 and is the only significant alteration made to the dwelling since its construction (NETR 1987, 1995).

Setting:

130 North Main Street is sited on a roughly rectangular-shaped parcel (Block 26.01, Lot 67) located on the southeast side of North Main Street in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing northwest and is set back approximately 87 feet from the road. An asphalt-paved driveway extends east from North Main Street and leads extends to the
