Description:

PS&S recommends that 4 Prospect Street, constructed ca. 1958, is a non-contributing property in the Cranbury Historic District.

The 1-story, side gable-roofed, rectangular plan main block of this aluminum siding-clad, frame dwelling on a concrete foundation is 6 bays wide and 3 bays deep and is fronted on the northwest by a 1-story, 1-bay, gabled porch and backed by a 1-story, gable-roofed el. A 3-bay, gable-roofed projecting volume is located in northeast bays of the northwest elevation. The roofs are predominantly clad in asphalt shingle and the windows predominantly have 6/6 sash with applied shutters. An interior brick chimney projects from the roof juncture of the projecting bay and the main volume. The front porch is accessed by a brick stair and includes wrought iron rails and posts. The primary entrance to the residence, located in the southwest bay of the projecting volume, includes a paneled door. The remaining bays of the projecting volume are regularly fenestrated. The main block is lighted by a multi-light picture window flanked by 2 smaller 6/6 windows in the northeast bay and by smaller double windows in the remaining bays. The northeast, side elevation is lighted by 2 single windows and includes a central secondary door. The southwest, side and southeast, rear elevations are not visible from the public right-of-way. A 1-story, gable-roofed garage, not visible from the public right-of-way, is located to the east of the residence. Historic maps indicate that Prospect Street was opened in the 3rd quarter of the 19th century and, by 1876, included 6 residences on its northwest side and 2 residences on its southeast side. The lot occupied by 4 Prospect Street remained undeveloped until the current residence's construction. Historic District as a "modern ranch." The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection parcel database indicates that the residence was constructed in 1958. Historic aerial photographs indicate that this building was constructed between 1957 and 1963 that there have been no major alteration campaigns since its completion.

4 Prospect Street was constructed after the period of significance for the Cranbury Historic District and therefore is a non-contributing property.

Prospect Street is a short, residential street that connects Bunker Hill Driver, to the southwest, to Plainsboro Road, to the northeast. The residences are predominantly single family dwellings of moderate size.

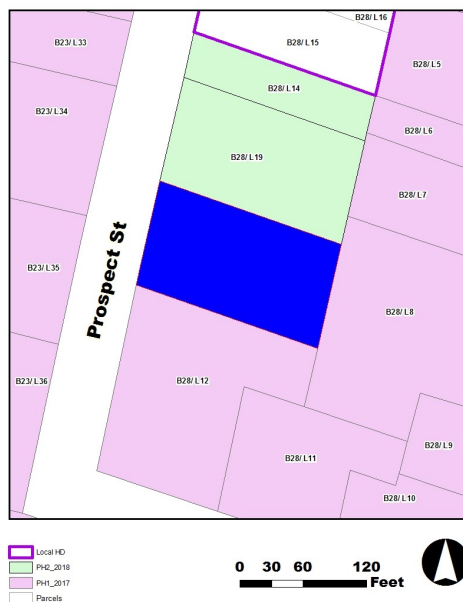
