Description:

70 North Main Street is a two-story tall, three-bay wide, three-bay deep, frame private residence constructed circa 1880 in a vernacular Greek Revival style. The dwelling consists of a rectangular, front-gabled main block; a two-story, two-bay addition to the rear; and a one-story partially enclosed wraparound porch. The roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles. A central interior, painted brick chimney pierces the roof at the ridgeline on the main block. The main block features molded wood eaves and a return cornice in the front gable end. The exterior of the dwelling is clad in wood clapboard siding on the front elevation and vinyl siding on the side elevations. Wood fish scale shingles cover the front gable end. Fenestration on the front elevation consists of one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement windows with louvered shutters on the first and second floors. There are two entrances, one located in the north bay on the main block and one on the partially enclosed wraparound porch. These modern doors have multiple inset lights above one rectangular panel. The wraparound porch shelters the first floor and is enclosed on the southwest elevation. The porch features a rounded southwest corner and unfluted Doric columns supporting the eaves. The columns are connected by a simple railing. The southwest elevation has one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement windows with louvered shutters on the first and second floors. A one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement window and four ten-light vinyl casement windows are located on the enclosed portion of the wraparound porch. The northeast elevation has one-over-one, vinyl-sash replacement windows on the first and second floors. Character-defining elements of the dwelling include the fish scale shingles in the front gable end and the one-story, partially enclosed wraparound porch. A one-story, side-gabled frame shed (constructed circa 1910) sits at the rear of the dwelling.

History: 70 North Main Street first appears cartographically on the 1916 Sanborn map of Cranbury Township as a two-story frame dwelling with a one-story wraparound porch with a one-story rear addition and a one-story addition to the southwest. A one-story frame outbuilding stands behind the dwelling. The 1933 Sanborn map shows the subject dwelling in its current form.

Setting:

70 North Main Street is sited on a rectangular parcel (Block 30, Lot 2.01) located on the east side of North Main Street in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing northwest and is set back approximately 10 feet from North Main Street. The portion of the sidewalk that spans the west side of the parcel is paved with bricks. Shrubs line the south and east sides of the parcel. The property is lightly wooded. A one-story frame shed is located to the rear (east) of the dwelling. 70 North Main Street is located in a mixed residential and commercial neighborhood surrounded by properties dating from the mid-nineteenth to the early twentieth century.

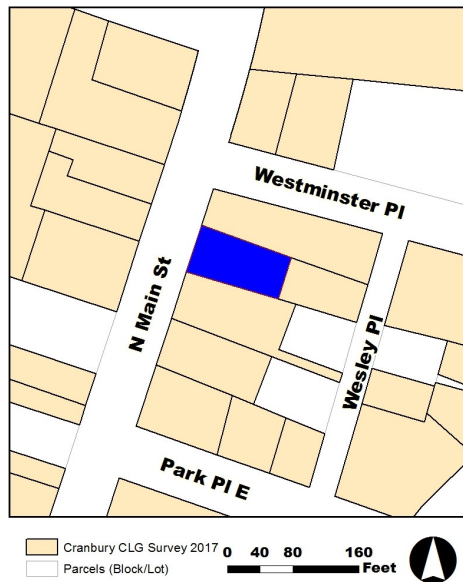
