Description:

66 North Main Street is a two-story tall, five-bay wide, two-bay deep, frame private residence constructed circa 1825 in a vernacular style. The dwelling, which has a brick foundation, has several additions: a two-story, two-bay wide, side-gabled addition to the northeast; a twostory, two-bay wide rear ell; and two one-story shed roof rear additions. The roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles. The exterior of the dwelling is clad in wood clapboard siding on the front elevation and aluminum siding on all other elevations. The gable ends of the main block have a molded wood return cornice. Windows on the front elevation are six-over-six, double-hung, wood-sash windows (likely original) on the second floor with nine-over-six, double-hung, replacement wood-sash windows on the first floor. A six-panel wood door within a molded wood surround with a pediment top is located in the central bay on the main block, accessed by a brick stoop. The northeast elevation has a louvered window in the gable end and six-over-six, replacement vinyl-sash windows on the first and second floors. A secondary entrance, a single door with six inset lights and an aluminum screen door, is located in the west bay. The rear elevation is not visible from the public right-of-way. The southwest elevation has four-light fixed wood windows in the gable end and a sixover-six, replacement vinyl-sash window on the first floor. The southwest elevation of the one-story shed roof addition has triple six-light fixed vinyl windows and a two-over-two vinyl-sash window on either side of a single door with twelve inset lights and a concrete stoop.

History: 66 North Main Street, constructed circa 1825, first appears cartographically on the 1861 Walling map of Cranbury Township, owned by "W. Bergen." It also appears on the 1872 Beers atlas, owned by "W. Hutchison," and the 1876 Everts and Stewart map, owned

by "Mrs. M.H. Bergen." The 1916 Sanborn map shows the subject dwelling as a two-story frame dwelling with a one-story front porch and multiple one-story rear additions. The 1933 Sanborn map shows a one-story frame garage on the property, removed by 1957. Historic aerial photographs show the subject dwelling in its current form as early as 1957. Earlier aerials are difficult to interpret for this property.

Setting:


66 North Main Street is sited on a rectangular parcel (Block 30, Lot 5) located on the east side of North Main Street in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing northwest and is set back approximately 10 feet from North Main Street. The portion of the sidewalk that spans the west side of the parcel is paved with bricks. A brick driveway extends west from North Main Street past the dwelling's southwest elevation. The backyard, planted in grass, is enclosed by a wood fence. The property is lightly wooded. 66 North Main Street is located in a mixed residential and commercial neighborhood surrounded by properties dating from the mid-nineteenth to the early twentieth century.
