Description:

7 Park Place East is a two-story tall, three-bay wide, two-bay deep, frame private residence constructed circa 1860 in a vernacular style. The rectangular dwelling sits on a stuccoed masonry foundation and has no additions. The basement level is raised. The front-gabled roof has overhanging eaves and is sheathed with asphalt shingles. An exterior stucco chimney pierces the roof on the southeast elevation. The exterior of the dwelling is clad in wood clapboard siding on the front (southwest) elevation and vinyl siding on the side and rear (northeast) elevations. Regular fenestration on the front elevation consists of six-over-six, double-hung, replacement wood-sash windows within molded wood surrounds. Windows on the basement level are six-over-six, double-hung, replacement wood-sash. The entrance, located in the east bay, consists of a single wood door with two long, vertical panels. The door is flanked by sidelights and topped by a rectangular transom and a dentil lintel. A one-story porch with turned wood posts and thin balusters shelters the entrance. The porch features a molded wood cornice supported by filigree brackets. Windows on the southeast elevation, clad in vinyl siding, are six-over-six, double-hung, replacement wood-sash windows within molded wood surrounds. Basement-level windows are six-over-six, double-hung, wood-sash. The rear elevation has six-over-six, double-hung, replacement wood-sash windows and a nine-light wood casement window within molded wood surrounds. The northwest elevation is not visible from the public right-of-way. Character-defining elements of the dwelling include overhanging eaves and wood-sash windows.

lot owned by "J. Snedeker." The second building depicted on the 1861 map is 5 Park Place East, located west of the subject dwelling. The 1872 Beers atlas and 1876 Everts and Stewart map indicate no change of ownership. The 1916 Sanborn map indicates the presence of a one-story frame outbuilding north of the subject dwelling. The 1933 Sanborn map shows that the one-story outbuilding was demolished but indicates no changes to the subject dwelling. The porch does not appear on either Sanborn map and was likely added to the subject dwelling in the second half of the twentieth century.

Setting:

7 Park Place East is sited on a rectangular parcel (Block 30, Lot 9) located on the north side of Park Place East in Cranbury Township, Middlesex County, New Jersey. The dwelling is oriented with its primary elevation facing southwest and is set back approximately 6 feet from Park Place East. A concrete sidewalk, which runs along the north side of Park Place East, spans the south side of the parcel. The property is enclosed by a wood fence. 7 Park Place East is located in a primarily residential neighborhood surrounded by residential properties dating from the mid-nineteenth to the early-twentieth century.


