Description:

PS&S recommends that the residence constructed in 2014 at 11 Maplewood Avenue does not contribute to the Cranbury Historic District, but that the pump station building associated with a demolished water tower formerly on this site is a contributing property in District.

The property at 11 Maplewood Avenue includes a recently constructed residence and garage.

The 2-story, gable-roofed, H-plan, vinyl siding-clad main volume of the residence is on a concrete foundation and is fronted by a 1-story, hip-roofed front porch. The residence is 5 bays wide and 6 bays deep. The roofs throughout are clad in asphalt shingle and the windows are predominantly 4-light or 8 light casements or have 4/4 vinyl sash with applied muntins. A primary entrance with door surround is accessed by the front porch on the east, main elevation. A secondary entrance is on the north, side elevation.

A 1 ½ -story, gable and shed-roofed, painted brick former pump station building is located to the northwest of the residence. Only partially visible from the public right-of-way, the building includes an entrance and window on its east elevation and a boarded window on the gable end.

Historic maps and aerial photographs indicate that this property was first developed with a water tower and pump station building between

1916 and 1933. The water tower was removed between 2008 and 2010 and the current residence was completed in 2014.

This property is non-contributing to the historic district by virtue of the construction of the residence after the period of significance. The pump station building, although constructed before 1940, is a fragment of the former use of the property and therefore does not contribute to the significance of the district.

Setting:

Maplewood Avenue is an approximately half-mile long primarily residential street that connects N. Main Street, to the northwest, to Route 130, to the northeast. Maplewood runs parallel to N. Main Street between Scott Ave. and Park Place, after which it turns to the northeast to form a southwest extension of Cranbury-South River Road.

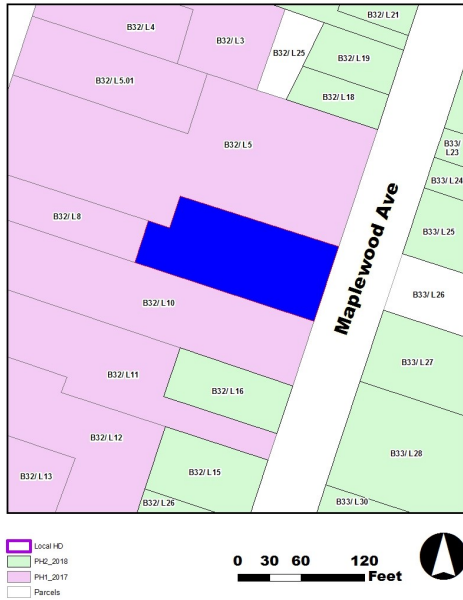

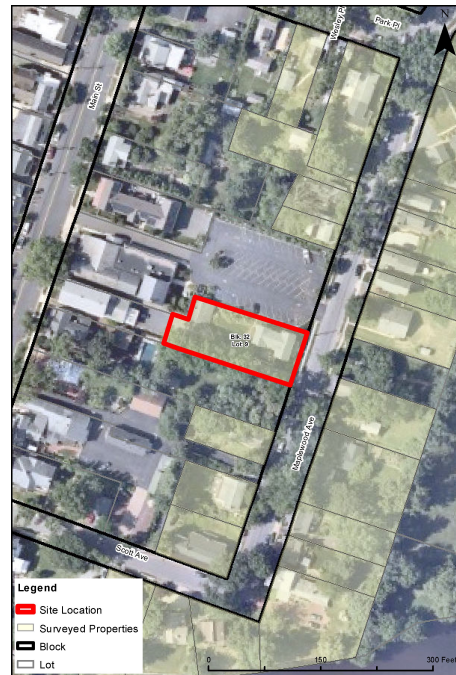
