Description:

PS&S recommends that this property, which includes buildings constructed in the 1960s, is a non-contributing property in the Cranbury Historic District.

The 1 ½-story, gable-roofed, rectangular plan, aluminum siding-clad, frame residence on a parged foundation is 3 bays wide and 3 bays deep. The roof is clad in asphalt shingles and the windows predominantly have 1/1 aluminum sash. A parged, interior chimney projects from the gable ridge in the northwest bay. The north and south elevations are clad in plywood siding. The southwest, main elevation includes the primary entrance door central bay, with a triple window in the northwest bay and a single window in the southeast bay. The northwest, street-facing elevation and southeast, side elevation are both lighted by a window in each bay of the first floor with 2 windows on the second floor. The northeast, rear elevation includes a secondary door in the central bay and a single window in the southeast and northwest bays.

A 1-story, gable-roofed, frame shed is located to the southeast of the residence.

Historic maps indicate that Maplewood Avenue remained largely undeveloped until after the middle of the 19th century. Historic maps and aerial photographs indicate that this lot was formerly occupied by a frame single residence and secondary buildings constructed before

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1916. Those buildings were replaced with the current ones between 1963 and 1969.

This property is a non-contributing property in the historic district by virtue of the buildings' construction date after 1940.

Setting:

Maplewood Avenue is an approximately half-mile long primarily residential street that connects N. Main Street, to the northwest, to Route 130, to the northeast. Maplewood runs parallel to N. Main Street between Scott Ave. and Park Place, after which it turns to the northeast to form a southwest extension of Cranbury-South River Road.

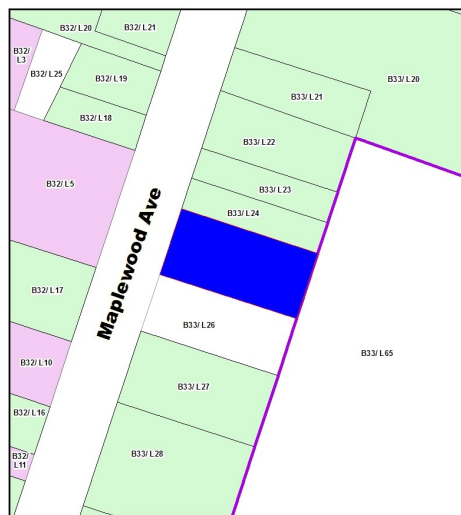
